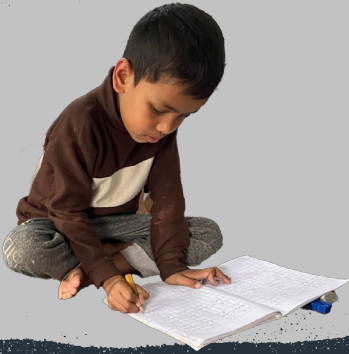


PRAYASS

The PRAYASS Project aspires to protect vulnerable children, youth, and women, especially in the Adult Entertainment Sector, through prevention, rescue, rehabilitation, and reintegration, fostering safety and awareness in communities.

CFS

The Child-Friendly Schools (CFS) Project aims to create safe, welcoming, and engaging learning environments in public schools. Since 2024, the follow-up phase has focused on sustaining progress through teacher training, parental education, community engagement and extracurricular activities etc.



SIQAEE

The SIQAEE Project, launched in January 2024, aims to transform community schools in Hupsekot and Baudikali, Nawalpur, into centers of excellence. It focuses on improving infrastructure, Early Childhood Development (ECD), teacher training, ICT integration, and community engagement to create inclusive and supportive learning environments.

FAB HOSPITALITY SCHOOL

The FAB Hospitality School, established in 2017 by Right4Children, offers specialized training in hospitality, including food and beverage service, housekeeping, and front office management. Partnering with GATE, FAB equips disadvantaged youth with skills for local and international careers, contributing to Nepal's tourism growth.



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
